Thurs 20th September 2018 (**D**, wine)

MEET IN ROME

Arriving in your own time to Rome, you will have plenty of time to check-in to our hotel, before we meet in the evening for our welcome banquet in a favourite local restaurant where you get to enjoy a real roman dinner

Accommodation: Hotel San Francesco, Rome - 5 nights in the heart of the Trastevere district with its own rooftop terrace and bar

Fri 21st September 2018 (B, D)

ROME - explore the heart of Rome & Vatican

Your local guide for the morning will take us on a journey not only of the main sights like Pantheon, Spanish steps, but away from the crowds to some amazing churches holding secrets of christ's followers: St Mary Major Basilica, St Philip Neri, St Agostino, S.Maria Sopra Minerva, S. Philip & St James the Lesser & more. Lunch and free time, before our experience of the Vatican is one most people miss, a private tour of the Vatican museum & sistine Chapel by night with buffet food in the Pinecone courtyard. VIP entrance

Sat 22nd September 2018 (B, D, wine)

ROME - Ancient Rome, Colosseum & Pope's summer residence

Our private guide takes us through a journey of ancient Rome, the Colosseum VIP, church of St Peters in chains, underground St Clements, the Mamertine prison where St Paul was imprisioned. After a lunch break, we explore the best kept secrets of Rome.. beyond the city walls to Castel Gandolfo the Pope's summer villa and gardens, the lakes and dinner in the piazza of Frascati looking out over St Peter's Dome as the sun sets.

Sun 23rd September 2018 **(B)**

ROME - St Peters Basilica

Mass at St Peters Baslica, before we head out with our local catholic guide to St Pauls outside the walls, the Catacombs on Appian Way where St Paul walked into Rome, Headquarters of the Knights of Malta, Basilica St Johns Lateren and the Holy stairs.

Mon 24th September 2018 **(B)**

ROME - Monasteries, Villas out of Rome

Today we take a look at some of Rome's lesser visited sights, including the Monastery of St Benedicts and his cave in Subiaco, Villa d'Este in Tivoli famous for its renassence water fountains.

Tues 25th September 2018 **ASSISI**

ASSISI

Departing Rome, we head north into Umbria to visit the lovely hilltop town of Orvieto, the Duomo and ancient caves, before arriving to Assisi and settle into your hotel before we explore the Basilica of St Francis.

Accommodation: Hotel Windsor Savoia, Assisi - 2 nights

in the heart of Assisi, you are just a short walk from the Basilica so you can enjoy your own time here and the lovely village evenings.

Wed 26th September 2018 **(B)**

Following St Francis, we explore the Baslica of St Francisa and St Clare, the Carceri Hermitage and the Monastery of ST Damiano.

Thurs 27th September 2018 **(B)**

SIENA - Tuscany & St Catherine

Our journey through Tuscany takes us through Montepulciano, Bagno di Vignoni (a Medici thermal courtyard), to Buonconvento (a stop along the old Pilgrim road Via Francigena). In Siena after check-in, our guide takes us through the sights of Slena including the Sanctuary of St Catherine, Basilica St Dominic, il Campo and the Duomoe. Along the way, we learn the stories and culture of these faithful servants and the Palio of Siena.

Accommodation: Hotel Italia , Siena - 1 nights

this lovely little Hotel is on the old pilgrim road entering Siena and just a short walks leads you into the heart of the old town.





Fri 28th

September 2018

Ariving into Florence, our local guide will take you|through Florence to visit Duomo, Santa Croce, VIP entrance to

Michelangelo's David in Academia, Ponte Vecchio & more. Dinner as a group is at a lovely local restaurant (**B**, **D**)

Accommodation: Hotel Loggiato dei Serviti, Florence - 1 nights

Nestled in the heart of old Florence, with a lovely piazza in front and just a few steps for the Academia & David or the Duomo.

FLORENCE

The morning is yours to enjoy from the markets, maybe the Uffizi or shopping, before we take the fast train to Venice where our local hosts will meet us and take us in style by private watertaxi to our hotel before our guide takes us on an orientation of Venice and dinner at a lovely typical local Venetian restaurant.
